



PASSIVHAUS HIGH SCHOOL SWIMMING POOL



Leca® Lightweight Fill 10-20mm (LWA) was recently specified for a swimming pool complex at Currie Community High School. This is in the first phase of the Scottish Government's Learning Estate Investment Programme and is going to be delivered in Spring 2025. The new school is being developed to Passivhaus

standards which provides comfort but uses little energy for heating and cooling - aiming to be the first Passivhaus secondary school with a swimming pool in Scotland.

Leca® LWA was pneumatically delivered to fill the voids around the perimeter of the new swimming pool - due to limited access of the facility, with a piping system reaching up to 50m to deliver the material.
